

## Canyon Ridge Christian Prep COVID Safety Code & Non-Compliance Procedure

First and foremost, CRCP Administrative Staff acknowledge that the school has been given special permission to hold in person classes at the church at present time as long as we are following the safety protocol that the Elders and church board have agreed on as well as the SECC guidelines that our church must follow. We want not only each student and parent to be safe, but also our volunteer teachers and staff.

With that in mind, the following safety protocols are in place for everyone at Canyon Ridge Christian Prep while on the campus. Please review the protocols with your children and let them know that the staff and teachers will be reminding them to follow the rules. We also ask that the parents help us with the enforcing of the safety rules.

- 1. **MASKS:** In compliance with the CDC guidelines, CA state guidelines, San Diego County guidelines and Southeastern California Conference of Seventh Day Adventists guidelines, Face coverings are **REQUIRED** for anyone on campus at all times, unless eating food or drinking.
- 2. **FOOD:** Canyon Ridge Christian Prep is not allowed to provide food for students. Students and families must bring their own lunch each week. Cooking class is also not allowed to hold classes until notified otherwise. We also ask that everyone remembers that we are not to be sharing food of any kind with each other while on campus. As much as possible, please eat with your family only.
- 3. **WATER BOTTLES:** As drinking fountains are turned off right now due to COVID, please remember to bring refillable water bottles to school to use. When a refill is needed, please ask either Ms. Linda Zinke or Mindy to go inside to fill up the water bottle for you.
- 4. **DISTANCING:** As much as possible, please try to follow the social distancing guidelines. When waiting for water bottles to be filled, try not to all congregate outside the door as that blocks traffic on the sidewalk and makes it difficult for people to pass.
- 5. **BATHROOMS:** Just a reminder that only 1 Person/ Family is allowed in the bathrooms at a time. Please do not gather and socialize in the bathrooms at any time.

We ask that each student, parent, teacher and staff comply with these rules at all times. We know that it might be inconvenient at times, but we ask that everyone follows the rules so we can keep meeting in person. If a student or parent fails to comply with the rules, the following non-compliance procedure has been adopted from our member handbook policies:

A. If a student or parent does not comply with the protocol outlined above, the student and parent will meet with the administrative staff to respond regarding their refusal to comply. If the staff feels that there is no cooperation, then the student and parent will be asked to leave the school and a letter of removal will be given within three to five days from the meeting. However, if the student and parent agree to comply, then the student will be placed on probation to determine their willingness to cooperate with the safety protocol.
